

Announcement

on the granting of a special license for customs offices pursuant to article 3 (2) Regulation (EC) No 273/2004 (Federal Gazette No 20 dated 28 January 2006, p. 592)

dated 16 January 2006

Pursuant to article 3 (2) sentence 2 Regulation (EC) No 273/2004 in conjunction with article 12 (2) Regulation (EC) No 1277/2005 a special license is granted to customs offices for possession and placing on the market scheduled substances listed in category 1 of the annex of Regulation (EC) No 273/2004. Pursuant to article 3 (2) sentence 3 Regulation (EC) No 273/2004 this license is valid only for the use of precursors within the scope of the official duties of customs offices concerned. It has come into effect retroactively with Regulation (EC) No 273/2004 on 18 August 2005. Please note that pursuant to article 4 Regulation (EC) No 273/2004 customs offices acquiring substances of category 1 are required to hand over a customer declaration to their suppliers (annex III of the above mentioned Council Regulation).
