Summary of Issue:

The Binding Site has identified that the quality control samples supplied with ZK044.L.R lot 415776 are reporting above their specified acceptance ranges. Investigation by The Binding Site has indicated that there is an approximately 90% likelihood of one or both the QC results reporting out of the above specified range. This indicates that affected kit assay performance has deteriorated since product release. The Binding Site has therefore decided to remove the affected kits from the field.

It is expected that sample results are affected to the same extent as the kit QCs. As stated in the instructions for use, where QC results report outside of the acceptance ranges, patient sample results should not be reported.
