- RE: Monitors B20 or B40 Software Version VSP-A_1.10 (or earlier) miss lethal arrhythmia alarm in NEONATAL mode

GE Healthcare has recently become aware of a potential safety issue due to disabling of 'V Tachy' and 'V Fib' alarms in NEONATAL mode of your Monitor B20 or B40. **Please ensure that all potential users in your facility are made aware of this safety notification and the recommended actions.**

Safety Issue	The 'V Tachy' and 'V Fib' alarms of Monitor B20 or B40 are disabled in NEONATAL mode which could result in a missed lethal arrhythmia alarm and a potentially critical event. Other modes and parameters are not affected.
Safety Instructions	The clinician should stop using monitor in NEONATAL mode.
Affected Product Details	The issue affects Monitor B20 or B40 devices with the software version VSP-A_1.10 (or earlier).
Product Correction	GE Healthcare will provide a software solution at no charge to correct this issue.
